## **General Licence to Harm Protected Animals** (Airport)

**Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016** 

## Licence conditions

- 1. Only the authorised person(s) named to perform the activity allowed by this licence may undertake the activity allowed by this licence.
- The licensee must maintain a true, accurate and up-to-date record of all protected animals harmed under the terms of this licence. A report of all protected animals harmed (species and number) must be received by the Wildlife Team at the end of the licence term.
- 3. A copy of the records, referred to in condition 2. must be provided for inspection on request by an authorised officer of National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS).
- 4. An authorised person operating under this licence must comply with any direction given by an authorised officer of NPWS.
- 5. May only harm animals in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedures or Code of Practice relevant to the species being harmed.
- 6. The licensee must promptly alleviate the suffering of any injured protected animals by quick and humane euthanasia of the animal.
- 7. Where possible, control activities should be conducted out of sight of the public.
- 8. The licensee is to bury the carcasses of the protected animals shot on the lands specified in this licence at a single location, which is readily identified
